IN THE MATTER OF LITTERING AND TRESSPASSING ON LANDS ADJOINING THE BOQUE CHITTO WATER PARK

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors of Pike County received a letter from Attorney Norman Gillis, Jr. in behalf of himself and two other property owners of land adjoining the Bogue Chitto Water Park, the said letter being dated October 13th, 1982 and being included in the minutes of this days proceedings, and;

WHEREAS, the said letter seeks the assistance of the Board of Supervisors in attempting to restrain tresspassing and littering on their property.

Upon motion made by Supervisor Doyle Forman, seconded by Supervisor Freddie Wall and unanimously carried, it is hereby ordered and adjudged that the Board Attorney propound a warning to be printed on the leaflets distributed by the Bogue Chitto Water Park warning people renting canoes and intertubes that they are not to tresspass or litter while in the Bogue Chitto River in the Water Park and asking them to refrain from doing the same on the property of Julius O'Quin, Evelyn Tate and N. B. Gillis, Jr.
