IN THE MATTER OF ADOPTING AN ORDINANCE REQUIRING PAWNBROKERS TO MAKE WRITTEN REPORTS TO THE PIKE COUNTY SHERIFFS OFFICE OF PAWNED OR PURCHASED ARTICLE, ETC.

At the request of Pike County Sheriff Duane Dillon, and to assist law enforcement agencies is solving crimes concerning stolen goods, motion was made that the following ordinance be adopted:

"ORDINANCE REQUIRING PAWNBROKERS TO MAKE WRITTEN REPORTS TO THE PIKE COUNTY SHERIFFS OFFICE OF PAWNED OR PURCHASED ARTICLES"

Every pawnbroker in the County of Pike is hereby required to make written reports to the Sheriffs Office of Pike County upon report forms furnished and paid for by the sheriffs office showing the receipt of all pawned articles and the purchase of all other articles, along with the name, description and address of each person pawning or selling said article. A complete description of said article showing serial number and identifying marks, along with the amount pawned on or paid for said article shall be included on said report. The report form shall be maintained as articles come in, and kept current. Report forms shall be mailed to the Pike Sounty Sheriffs Office at the close of each week's business showing the articles pawned or purchased during said week. Violation of this ordinance shall constitute a misdemeanor. This ordinance shall take effect immediately after passage.

Passed by order of the Board of Supervisors of Pike County, Mississippi, this 4th day of December, A.D., 1985."
