IN THE MATTER OF ENACTING A COUNTY-WIDE ORDINANCE MAKING PRIVILEGE  
LICENSES EXPIRE ONE YEAR FROM THE DATE OF ISSUANCE AS AUTHORIZED  
BY SECTION 27-17-463, MCA 1972

Upon motion of Supervisor Freddie Wall, seconded by Supervisor Theodore Bullock, with all members of the Board present and voting "For", the Board of Supervisors adopted an ordinance determining to issue privilege licenses which shall expire one year from the date of issuance, as follows:

ORDINANCE DETERMINING TO ISSUE PRIVILEGE LICENSES WHICH SHALL  
EXPIRE ONE YEAR FROM THE DATE OF ISSUANCE AS AUTHORIZED  
BY SECTION 27-17-463, MCA, 1972

WHEREAS, upon the advice of Hon. Joe B. Young, Pike County Tax Assessor/Collector, the present method of renewing privilege licenses one year from the date of issuance is working satisfactorily in that it provides privilege license revenue throughout the whole year, and

WHEREAS, upon the further advice of the Tax Assessor/Collector there would no benefit to be gained from requiring all privilege licenses to expire on the same date and be renewed on the same date, rather to provide for a one date expiration would overburden the privilege license department of the Tax Assessor/Collector's office, and

WHEREAS, it appears to be to the best interest, not only of the citizens of Pike County who buy privilege licenses, but to the privilege license department of the Tax Assessor/Collector's office that the present method of renewing privilege licenses one year from the date of issuance be continued.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Pike County Board of Supervisors as follows:

SECTION ONE: That all county privilege licenses shall expire one year from their date of issuance.

SECTION TWO: A copy of this ordinance shall be published for three (3) consecutive weeks in a newspaper published and circulated in Pike County. This ordinance and order shall take effect and be in force after the eighth (8th) day following the last publication authorized herein.

The above ordinance and order having been introduced and read at a public meeting of this Board on June 30, 1988, was considered, passed, and adopted, section by section, and then as a whole by the following vote:

Voting Aye - Five (5)

Voting Nay - None

Present and Not Voting - None

Absent and Not Voting - None.
