Rawls of the Mississippi State Department of Health dated October 12, 1987 to the City of McComb which letter discusses the state law requirement that residents of the Baertown Community connect to the available sewer, and

WHEREAS, the same laws which apply to the residents of the Baertown Community will also apply to the residents of the Fernwood Community, and WHEREAS, it is necessary that this Board adopt an ordinance requiring Fernwood residents to connect to the Fernwood sewer system to comply with state law,

NOW, THEREFORE, on motion of Supervisor Freddie Wall, seconded by Supervisor A. Marks, and carried by the affirmative vote of all five (5) Supervisors, the Board adopted the following ordinance:
