IN THE MATTER OF AN AMENDMENT TO THE PIKE COUNTY ORDINANCE
CREATING THE E-911 BOARD

The Board of Supervisors has discussed an amendment to its E-911 ordinance which would specifically authorize the use of emergency telephone surcharge collections for the purchase of street signage to be used within the municipalities of the county;


And it was further discussed that the use of these funds for this purpose is consistent with saving of life, reduction in destruction of property, and quicker apprehension of criminals, and is in all respects consistent with the purposes of § 19-5-303, Mississippi Code Ann.:

On Motion by Supervisor Lexie Elmore, seconded by Supervisor Carroll Fortenberry, the following resolution was unanimously adopted:

That the Pike County Ordinance providing for E-911 commission in Pike County, Mississippi should be and is hereby amended to add thereto the following specific authorization: The E-911 commission should be and is hereby authorized and permitted to use emergency telephone surcharges for the purpose of the purchase of signage to be provided the various municipalities within the County.
