

IN THE MATTER OF AN AMENDMENT TO THE COUNTY
ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING RESTRICTIONS ON USE OF
LOUD RADIOS, MUSICAL INSTRUMENTS, PHONOGRAPHS,
TELEVISIONS, OR OTHER MACHINES OR DEVICES

WHEREAS, it appears unto the Board of Supervisors that there exists as ordinance which establishes restrictions on use of loud radios, musical instruments, phonographs, televisions, or other machines or devices, which ordinance was passed by the Board of Supervisors at its meeting on October 6, 2008;

WHEREAS, it affirmatively appears unto the Board of Supervisors that the general welfare, safety and health of the citizens of Pike County, Mississippi will be promoted by an amendment to the aforesaid ordinance, to allow for a temporary permit, under specified times, terms, and conditions, to allow the use of radios, musical instruments, phonographs, televisions, or other machines or devices, by virtue of a permit for such use to be issued by the Board of Supervisors, after examination of the proposal by the Board of Supervisors;

NOW, THEREFORE, on motion made and duly seconded, it is hereby ordered and adjudged as follows:

That certain ordinance establishing restrictions on use of loud radios, musical instruments, phonographs, televisions, or other machines or devices, which ordinance was passed on October 6, 2008, should be and is hereby amended to add thereto the following:

SECTION 8: A permit for temporary use of loud radios, musical instruments, phonographs, televisions, or other machines or devices, as restricted in the ordinance dated October 6, 2008 shall be issued by the Board of Supervisors, after examination of the proposal by the county administrator. No persons shall use such devices or equipment without a temporary permit therefore issued by the Board of Supervisors, specifying the

time, date, and any other conditions attached to the permit as issued by the Board of Supervisors.

In all other respects the ordinance of the Board of Supervisors establishing restrictions on use of loud radios, musical instruments, phonographs, televisions, or other machines or devices, as passed by ordinance dated October 6, 2008, shall remain in full force and effect.

The clerk of the Board of Supervisors is hereby directed to cause this Order to be published in a newspaper having general circulation in Pike County, Mississippi.
